

Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to us, which is why we have a straight-forward privacy policy that has been designed to protect your personal and corporate information.

Any information that we collect from you will be kept confidential and **never** be sold, traded, or otherwise voluntarily disclosed to any individual or any organization outside of StatsLog Software Corporation, for any purpose, except as stated in the **Exceptions** section below.

What Information Is Covered By This Policy?

All information we receive from you is covered by this policy. This includes information received in person, by mail (electronic or physical), over the phone, through the course of business or technical support, or in any other way.

Examples:

- Everything you submit to StatsLog Software in order to register or activate an account, membership, or software product.
- Everything collected by our software products to validate licenses, and/or assist in technical support.
- Everything you submit to StatsLog Software in response to a poll, questionnaire, etc...
- Everything you send by e-mail to any @statslog.com address.
- All voice mail messages left at any StatsLog owned phone number.
- All cookies, analytic, or statistical information collected when visiting statslog.com or other StatsLog owned/operated websites.

Exceptions

There are only four exceptions to what we have stated above:

- Where required by law, we will provide any information to the appropriate authorities and/or agencies when presented with a legitimate legal request.
- We have your written permission to share your contact information with any party or parties outside of StatsLog Software Corporation for a specific stated purpose (for example, a technical support request may require the involvement of a third-party software vendor).
- We are announcing a business relationship with your firm in the form of a press release, or public announcement
- Anonymized, aggregate data that may have been based on some of your information may be presented to other members or the public in the form of newsletters, blog posts, case studies, etc...

Why We Collect Your Information

- To provide and improve our products, services and support.
- To offer you special deals and rates on our products, services, and support.
- To discover industry trends that we can keep you informed about through newsletters, blogs, etc...
- To issue press releases. For example, announcements of a business relationship with your firm.

Future Changes To Our Privacy Policy

We do not plan to change our privacy policy. However, in the event that changes to the privacy policy are ever required, you will be given ample notice with an easy and unchallenged option to have all of your personal information removed from our possession before the changes to the privacy policy are enacted. If we are unable to receive a response from you regarding a change to our privacy policy, we will assume that you want to opt-out and have your personal information removed from our possession.
